Optical ports on a switch are used to connect devices via fiber optic cables, enabling high-speed, long-distance data transmission.

Purpose of Optical Ports

Optical ports on switches allow network devices to communicate over

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network connectivity, providing flexibility and performance that electrical ports alone cannot achieve.

Mechanical optical switches physically move a fiber, prism, or mirror to redirect the light

Ethernet ports on switches already integrate Ethernet port modules internally, eliminating the need for optical-electrical

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Fiber-optic switches generally allow for rerouting optical signals in fibers, mainly in optical fiber communications.
