

Price of 36-core fiber optic splicing

Splicing Labor Costs

For commercial fiber projects, fusion splicing costs generally range from \$50 to \$150 per splice point, depending on factors such as site conditions, fiber type, and project size (e.g., aerial vs. underground splicing) (Splicelist.com) . A 36-core fiber cable would have 36 splice points per closure, so the labor cost alone could range from \$1,800 to \$5,400 for a single closure. 36-Core Fiber Splice Closures

A 36-core fiber optic splice closure is required to house and protect the spliced fibers. For example, closures made of PP+GF material with IP68 protection and turnable splice trays are available, suitable for overhead, embedded, or manhole installations (Fibconet) . Prices for these closures vary by manufacturer and region but typically range from \$50 to \$150 per unit, depending on quality and features.

Fusion Splicer Equipment

High-quality fusion splicers are essential for low-loss, reliable splicing. Popular models include Fujikura 90S+, INNO View 8+, and Sumitomo Type-72C+, with prices ranging from \$3,000 to \$15,000 depending on features like core alignment, ribbon fiber support, and automated cleave checking (Amerifiber) . For smaller projects, cost-effective options like the TEKCN Super X single-core splicer are available at lower prices (Splicemarket.com) .

- o Site conditions: Underground vaults or confined spaces increase labor costs due to safety and equipment requirements.
- o Testing and verification: OTDR testing is often included in per-splice pricing but may add extra cost if extensive testing is required.
- o Accessories: Splice sleeves, trays, and protective closures are additional costs to consider.
