The EU Recognition Directive regulates the recognition of professional qualifications in the EU and enables free access to the labour market.

The general system of recognition enables workers to have their professional qualification recognised in another EU country.

In the professional recognition process, you can check your qualifications acquired abroad and have their equivalence determined with the qualifications in the target country.

For professionals that want to move to another EU country (cases of permanent establishment), recognition of professional qualifications is necessary.
