

Quickly install support for cable trays

- o Attach supports securely using expansion bolts, nuts, and washers. Ensure all supports are level and aligned.
- o Connect suspension rods to hoisting frames or cross arms for vertical support .

Step 4: Place and Secure Trays

- o Measure and cut trays to fit the route, deburring edges to prevent cable damage .
- o Lift trays onto supports and secure with hold-down clips or bolts.
- o Join sections using couplers or splice plates to maintain continuity .

Step 5: Final Checks

- o Verify support spacing and tray alignment.
- o Ensure grounding and bonding are properly installed to meet NEC Article 392 requirements .
- o Check cable fill ratios to prevent overheating and maintain code compliance . By following these steps and
