Most ASUS ROG routers, including the latest WiFi 7 models, do not natively support optical SFP/SFP+ modules, but some high-end models feature 10G Ethernet ports that can connect to fiber via media converters.

Overview of ROG Router Connectivity

ASUS ROG routers, such as the ROG Rapture GT-BE98 Pro, are designed for high-performance gaming and networking, offering features like quad-band WiFi 7, multi-gig LAN/WAN ports, and up to 31 Gbps wired capacity . These routers include dual 10G ports and four 2.5G ports, which provide extremely fast wired connections for gaming PCs, NAS devices, or high-speed internet links .

Optical Module Compatibility

- o Native SFP/SFP+ support: ROG routers generally do not include SFP or SFP+ slots, which are required for direct optical module installation. Optical modules like Cisco 10GBASE SFP+ are designed for switches or routers with dedicated SFP+ ports .
- o Alternative connection: Users can connect ROG routers to fiber networks using 10G Ethernet ports with media converters. A media converter can translate fiber-optic signals to copper Ethernet, allowing the router to interface with optical networks without native SFP support.

Practical Implications

- o For home or gaming setups, the 10G Ethernet ports on high-end ROG routers are sufficient for most high-speed internet and LAN applications.
- o For enterprise or data center environments requiring direct SFP/SFP+ optical connections, a dedicated switch with SFP+ support is recommended, with the ROG router connected downstream via standard Ethernet.

Conclusion

While ROG routers excel in high-speed wired and wireless performance, they do not natively support optical modules. Users needing fiber connectivity must use media converters or compatible switches to integrate optical links into their network. For gaming and home networking, the built-in 10G ports provide ample bandwidth for most applications .
