In its most common form, a cube, a beam splitter is made from two triangular glass which are glued together at their base using polyester, or urethane-based adhesives. Common Log Splitter Problems And What To Do When They Appear Hydraulic log splitter systems use pressurised fluid to generate the force behind a wedge that splits wood. If your splitter feels weak or

In my case I needed a plate BS in a weakly converging beam. Adjust the wedge so that the ghost is "thrown" just off the camera. By adjusting the wedge and the thickness, you can also correct for the

To mitigate ghosting, Thorlabs may apply an anti-reflective (AR) coating, 30 arcmin wedge, or a combination of the two to the back surface of some of our plate beamsplitters. In high-sensitivity

Some beam splitters are polarizing, others are non-polarizing. There are also devices designed for use with only one polarization direction -- for example, with

These beamsplitters can separate components of a laser beam based on wavelength, or to truly combine different wavelengths (or bands) with minimal loss, and are thus suitable for high power

For optimum results, the incident light beam should enter the beamsplitter through the prism that has been coated with reflecting film so that reflection occurs before
