In typical residential or commercial distribution boxes, resistors are not standard components. The system does not require resistors to limit current because circuit breakers and fuses perform this protective function. Resistors may appear in specialized applications, such as:

- o Surge protection circuits: Small resistive elements may be used in combination with varistors or capacitors to absorb transient voltage spikes.
- o Current sensing: Shunt resistors can be used in smart DB boxes to measure current for energy monitoring and metering purposes .
- o Load balancing in industrial panels: Rarely, resistors may be used in complex industrial setups to balance currents or limit inrush currents.
