- o Temporary and Permanent Signs: Temporary signs may use A-frames for short-term projects, while permanent signs can be mounted on walls, posts, or adhesive-backed labels .
- o Warning Tapes and Markers: Detectable or non-detectable warning tapes, reflective labels, and flexible line marker posts are used to mark underground cables at ground level for added visibility .

- o Use bold fonts and high-contrast colors to maximize visibility .
- o Place signs at eye level or along the cable route to ensure they are easily seen .
- o Mounting options include adhesive backing, screw holes, brackets, or posts, depending on the surface and environment .
- o Signs should be updated if regulations change, damage occurs, or facility layouts evolve .
