

## Article Overview

Cable trays in Samoa should be sealed using fire-resistant materials and methods to prevent fire and smoke spread, following international best practices for firestopping and electrical safety.

## Firestopping and Sealing Principles

Cable trays passing through walls, floors, or electrical shafts must be tightly sealed with firestopping materials to maintain the integrity of fire-rated structures. Openings should be free of visible cracks or voids, and large gaps may require a fire-resistant backing plate before sealing. Firestop materials can include fire-rated boards, firestop packs, intumescent caulks, or mineral wool, ensuring that gaps around cables do not exceed 1 cm<sup>2</sup> and packing thickness is at least 24 cm . Cover plates should be square, evenly painted, and properly dimensioned to close the opening securely .

## Material Selection

- o Indoor trays: Painted steel or galvanized steel
- o Outdoor or high-humidity environments: Hot-dip galvanized steel, stainless steel, aluminum alloy, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic
- o Fireproof coatings: Primers and coatings should provide adhesion, corrosion resistance, and fire resistance. Coating thickness must meet design specifications and be verified through adhesion and fire-resistance tests .

## Installation Guidelines

- o Route planning: Align cable trays with building architecture, avoiding unnecessary crossings or detours. Maintain separation between power and signal cables to reduce electromagnetic interference .
- o Mechanical integrity: Ensure tray width, thickness, and support spacing are sufficient to prevent deformation under full cable load .
- o Sealing process: Install firestop packs in an orderly sequence, ensuring complete internal and external sealing of metal trunking. Use intumescent caulks or moldable putty for penetrations through fire-rated walls .

## Maintenance and Compliance

Regular inspections are essential to detect wear, corrosion, or coating degradation. Protective coatings should be reapplied as needed to maintain fire resistance. Documentation of inspections, coating thickness, and firestop installation should be maintained for compliance and future reference . By following these guidelines, cable tray installations in Samoa can achieve fire safety, structural integrity, and long-term reliability, even in the absence of specific local regulations, by adhering to recognized international standards .
