A secondary distribution box (SDB) is an intermediate electrical panel that receives power from the main distribution box and distributes it to specific areas, buildings, or floors, typically handling three-phase power for equipment.

Function and Role

A secondary distribution box serves as a sub-distribution point in a multi-level electrical system. It receives power from the primary distribution cabinet (connected to the transformer) and distributes it to specific zones, such as individual buildings, floors, or large equipment modules . Unlike tertiary distribution boxes, which supply single-phase power to individual devices or households, secondary boxes typically handle three-phase power and are designed for higher load capacities .

Design and Features

Secondary distribution boxes are designed for both safety and durability, often featuring:

- o Inner and outer doors for secure access and protection .
- o Powder-coated or sprayed exteriors for corrosion resistance and aesthetic appeal .
- o Rainproof tops for outdoor installation .
- o Copper busbars for main connections to ensure reliable conductivity .
- o Terminal blocks for custom wiring and flexible circuit connections .
- o Front-opening doors and bottom entry/exit for cables, facilitating easy installation and maintenance .

Components

The internal components of a secondary distribution box typically include:

- o Large three-phase circuit breakers to protect equipment and circuits .
- o Optional residual current devices (RCDs) for additional safety, forming part of a multi-level protection system .
- o Metering systems for monitoring power usage in specific areas .

Applications

Secondary distribution boxes are widely used in:

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- o Construction sites, where temporary power distribution is required .
- o Residential or commercial buildings, distributing power from the main transformer to each building or floor .
- o Industrial facilities, feeding power to machinery or equipment modules .

Safety and Standards

Secondary distribution boxes are part of a three-tier protection system:

- o Primary distribution box - main power intake from the transformer.
- o Secondary distribution box - intermediate distribution to buildings or floors.
- o Tertiary distribution box - final connection to individual devices or households. This system ensures "one machine, one switch, one protection", preventing multiple devices from being controlled by a single switch and enhancing electrical safety .
