- o **Installation Environment:** Indoor boxes are typically ABS plastic, wall-mountable, and compact for residential or office use.

- o Strip and clean the fiber jacket and coating carefully.
- o Cleave fibers precisely for low-loss splicing.
- o Secure fibers in the splice tray or termination box, maintaining bend radius and labeling for easy

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identification.

o Use protective covers to prevent dust and mechanical damage. For a simple, reliable solution for 4-core fiber, a small FTTH termination box or a dedicated 4-core splice tray inside a fiber enclosure is typically the most practical choice, balancing ease of installation, protection, and fiber management .
