There is no direct Singapore-based branch in Fiji, but international connectivity is possible via submarine cables and local fiber optic providers.

Submarine Cable Connectivity

Fiji's international fiber connectivity is primarily supported by submarine cables. The Echo Cable System, co-owned by Facebook and Google, connects Singapore to the Pacific region, including branches in Guam and Indonesia, which can facilitate high-capacity data transmission to Fiji through regional interconnections . This system provides a design capacity of 12 Tb/s per fiber pair, ensuring robust international bandwidth for Pacific nations.

Local Fiber Optic Providers in Fiji

Several local companies manage fiber optic infrastructure and services within Fiji:

- o Telecom Fiji has been actively expanding its fiber network, including the Savusavu to Labasa Fibre Project, which strengthens connectivity in Vanua Levu and links to submarine cable landing stations in Savusavu . The ongoing North Fiber Optical Project further extends high-capacity fiber to support businesses, schools, and communities, providing a foundation for 5G deployment .
- o Datec Fiji offers end-to-end fiber optic services, including design, installation, splicing, testing, and maintenance for commercial, industrial, and government clients .
- o iMatai Limited is a Fiji-owned company providing advanced data and communication network solutions across the Pacific, with expertise in deploying complex fiber networks .

Practical Implications

While there is no physical Singapore branch in Fiji, businesses and organizations in Fiji can access high-speed international connectivity through local providers connected to submarine cables linking to Singapore. Companies seeking Singapore-Fiji data links can coordinate with Telecom Fiji, Datec, or iMatai for installation, maintenance, and international bandwidth provisioning. In summary, Singapore-Fiji fiber connectivity exists via submarine cables, and local Fijian providers manage the distribution and maintenance of fiber networks, ensuring reliable access to international data services.
