- o Amperage and Modern Loads: Residential 200A panels are now standard for new homes, especially with EV chargers or smart home systems. Smaller 100A panels may be undersized for modern requirements .
- o Accessibility: Ensure enough wall space for door opening and maintenance access. Indoor boxes can be smaller; outdoor or industrial boxes often need extra room for weatherproofing and cooling components.

- o Check manufacturer families: Standardized size families allow scaling without switching product series .
