

Standard 19-inch size network rack

A 19-inch network rack has a standardized width of 19 inches (482.6 mm) and uses rack units (U) of 1.75 inches (44.45 mm) for height, with variable depths typically ranging from 600 mm to 1200 mm.

Standard Dimensions

- o Width: The front panel width of all 19-inch rack-mountable equipment is 19 inches (482.6 mm), including the mounting ears that secure devices to the rack frame .
- o Height: Measured in rack units (U), where 1U = 1.75 inches (44.45 mm). Common rack heights include 42U, 45U, and 48U, with 42U being the most widely used in data centers .
- o Depth: Depth varies depending on equipment and cooling needs, typically 600 mm to 1200 mm (24-48 inches). Shallow racks (600-800 mm) are suitable for switches and patch panels, while deeper racks (1000-1200 mm) accommodate servers and storage arrays .
