- o Depth and Internal Volume: Adequate depth ensures proper wire fill, safe splicing, and compliance with NEC wire-fill guidelines .
- o IP Rating: For outdoor or damp locations, choose boxes with IP44-IP67 protection to prevent moisture ingress .
- o Future-Proofing: Consider extra slots and space for potential upgrades like EV chargers, smart home systems, or additional circuits .
