

Standard thickness of steel plate for household electrical distribution boxes

The steel plate used for the enclosure of distribution boxes shall have a thickness of not less than 1. For most industrial electrical enclosures, 14-gauge (1.7 mm) is the workhorse for NEMA 4/4X wall and floor units, and 10-gauge or heavier belongs on anything that needs to resist impact, heavy door slam, or hold a lot of internal weight. 5mm steel sheets provide adequate protection and cost savings for standard outdoor applications, a 2. -.
