Proper installation of Swiss terminal boxes ensures safe energy distribution in hazardous areas while complying with international standards like ATEX and IECEx.

Key Considerations for Installation

1. Compliance and Certification Swiss terminal boxes, such as those from R. STAHL or Pepperl+Fuchs, are certified for hazardous areas under standards like ATEX, IECEx, and NEC. Ensure the selected terminal box matches the zone classification (Zone 1, Zone 2, Zone 21, Zone 22) or Class I/II Division 2 requirements for your site . 2. Material Selection Choose enclosures made from glass fiber reinforced polyester (GRP), brushed stainless steel, or aluminum depending on environmental conditions. These materials provide mechanical strength, chemical resistance, and temperature tolerance, suitable for offshore, chemical, or hygienic applications . 3. Cable Routing and Termination

- o Use appropriate cable glands and accessories to maintain the enclosure's protection rating (IP66, NEMA Type 4X).
- o Ensure cables are routed without sharp bends and avoid over-tightening to prevent damage.
- o Follow manufacturer recommendations for power types and voltage ratings to prevent electrical hazards . 4.

Installation Environment

- o Perform installation in a non-explosive environment.
 - o Avoid disassembling or modifying the terminal box yourself; only authorized personnel should handle maintenance .
 - o Regularly inspect and replace accessories to maintain safety and performance.
5. Mounting and Maintenance
- o Secure the terminal box to a stable surface using appropriate fasteners.
 - o Maintain clearance around the box for ventilation and access.
 - o Periodically check for corrosion, loose connections, or damage to ensure long-term reliability . 6.

Documentation and Safety

- o Keep installation manuals and certificates on-site.
- o Verify that all wiring and connections comply with local electrical codes and safety regulations.
- o Train personnel on safe handling and emergency procedures in hazardous areas. By following these guidelines, Swiss terminal boxes can be installed safely and efficiently, ensuring reliable power and signal distribution in industrial and hazardous environments while maintaining compliance with international safety standards .
