A network switch can be directly connected to another switch using fiber optic cables via SFP or SFP+ transceiver modules, supporting high-speed, long-distance data transmission.

Key Components for Direct Fiber Connection

- o **Fiber Optic Cables:** Choose between single-mode (for long distances) or multi-mode (for shorter distances) fiber depending on your network requirements . Duplex fiber is typically used, with separate strands for transmitting and receiving data .

- o **Use Duplex Fiber Cables:** Connect the transmit (TX) port of one switch to the receive (RX) port of the other, and vice versa, ensuring proper strand orientation .
- o **Verify Compatibility:** Confirm that both switches use the same fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode), wavelength, and optical power range .
- o **Configure Switch Ports:** Enable the fiber ports on each switch and configure them according to your network topology, such as point-to-point or cascaded connections .

- o Ensure matching SFP modules for both switches to avoid signal loss.
- o For multi-switch setups, consider cascading limits; typically, no more than four layers are recommended for optimal performance .
