A directly wired distribution box receives the main electrical supply straight into its main switch or MCB, distributing power to multiple circuits through protective devices without intermediate plug-in connections.

Overview

A distribution box, also called a consumer unit or panelboard, is the central point where incoming electricity is split into multiple circuits, each protected by devices like MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers), RCBOs (Residual Current Breakers with Overcurrent protection), or RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers) . In a directly wired setup, the main supply wires--phase and neutral--are connected directly to the main switch or main MCB inside the box, which then feeds the branch circuits .

Components and Wiring

- o Main Switch/MCB: The incoming supply is connected to a double-pole MCB or main switch, which controls the entire installation .
- o Busbars: Copper or aluminum bars distribute current from the main input to individual circuit breakers .
- o Circuit Breakers: Single-pole or double-pole MCBs protect each outgoing circuit from overloads or short circuits .
- o Neutral and Earth Bars: These provide a common connection point for neutral and grounding wires, ensuring safety and proper operation . In a directly wired distribution box, all connections are permanent, meaning wires are secured to terminals or busbars rather than using plug-in breakers. This method is common in residential and commercial installations where reliability and safety are priorities .

Safety Considerations

Direct wiring requires careful installation to prevent loose connections, overheating, or accidental contact with live parts. Protective devices like MCBs and RCCBs are essential to cut off power during faults, preventing damage or fire hazards . Proper grounding and adherence to local electrical codes are critical for safe operation.
