Most cables are short lengths, rarely longer than a few hundred feet, with 2 to 48 fibers per cable typically. The fiber is mostly multimode, except for the enlightened user who installs hybrid cable with

An Optical network is basically a communication network used for the exchange of information through an optical fiber cable between one end to another.

In essence, while optical fiber forms the core technology enabling high-speed data transmission, optical fiber cables are the infrastructure that
