- o Test Signal Strength: Use a power meter or Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to measure signal loss. Values outside the normal range (-15dBm to -30dBm) indicate issues .
- o Verify Hardware Functionality: Swap suspect transceivers with known-good units, reboot switches or routers, and check indicator lights for LOS signals .
- o Audit Network Configuration: Ensure firmware is up to date, check for IP conflicts, and verify routing settings .
- o Advanced Diagnostics: For long-haul or hidden breaks, OTDR testing can pinpoint the exact location of the fault .

Preventive Measures

- o Use armored or industrial-grade fiber in high-risk areas.
- o Maintain proper bend radius and clearly mark cable pathways.
- o Schedule regular inspections and cleaning to prevent contamination.
- o Monitor network performance with tools like PRTG or Wireshark to detect early signs of degradation . By following these steps, you can systematically identify whether the problem is physical, hardware-related, or



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configuration-based, and take corrective action to restore broadband connectivity.
