- o E2000: Equipped with automatic shutter for ferrule protection, commonly used in telecom for safety and reliability .
- o VSFF (Very Small Form Factor) Connectors: Includes CS, SN, and MDC connectors, designed for extreme port density in modern transceivers like QSFP-DD and OSFP .

- o Power Jack: Designed for high-power fiber optic applications, often used in industrial or high-performance systems .
- o SCRJ, SMA, TNC, VF-45: Additional specialized connectors supporting multimode, singlemode, and polymer optical fiber (POF) applications .
