

Warranty period for electrical distribution boxes

Legal Guarantees

In the European Union, consumers are entitled to a minimum 2-year legal guarantee against faulty goods, which applies regardless of the manufacturer's commercial warranty . This legal guarantee ensures that if a distribution box is defective or does not perform as advertised, the seller or manufacturer is responsible for repair, replacement, or refund. Some countries may require longer guarantees under national law.

- o Coverage Scope: Check whether the warranty covers only manufacturing defects or also performance issues, surge protection, and technical support.
- o Activation: Some warranties, like Schneider Electric's, require registration to activate the coverage.
- o Maintenance Requirements: Warranties often depend on proper installation and maintenance; failure to follow guidelines can void coverage.
- o Extended Warranties: Some manufacturers offer extended coverage or preventive maintenance contracts for additional protection.
