Ladder Cable Trays

They provide continuous cable support while allowing some airflow, making them suitable for telecommunication, fiber-optic, and control cables in commercial buildings. Perforated trays are often used where moderate ventilation is sufficient and some protection from dust or debris is needed .

Solid Bottom Cable Trays

Solid bottom trays have a continuous base and sides, fully enclosing the cables. This design offers maximum protection from dust, moisture, and physical interference, making them ideal for sensitive control, instrumentation, and fiber-optic cables. However, they provide limited ventilation, so they are less suitable for high-current power cables that generate significant heat .

Trough Cable Trays

Trough trays, also called ventilated troughs, combine features of ladder and solid trays. They have a ventilated bottom with side rails, providing good cable support and moderate airflow. Trough trays are versatile and often used in commercial and industrial applications where a compromise between protection and ventilation is required .

Wire Mesh (Basket) Cable Trays

Wire mesh trays are made from welded steel or aluminum mesh, offering a lightweight and flexible solution. They are easy to install and ideal for data, low-voltage, and network cabling. Wire mesh trays allow excellent
