G.657A1/A2 bend-insensitive variants are used in tight spaces or FTTH (Fiber to the Home) deployments, reducing signal degradation in curved installations . **Multimode Fibers (MMF):** These fibers have larger cores (50-62.5um) and support multiple light modes, making them suitable for short-distance, high-speed links such as LANs and data centers. Common standards include OM1 (orange), OM2 (orange), OM3 (aqua), OM4 (violet), and OM5 (lime green), each supporting increasing bandwidth and distance . **Armored and Bend-Insensitive Fibers:** In environments where physical stress or tight routing is expected, armored patch cords or fibers with Kevlar reinforcement provide extra durability. Bend-insensitive fibers prevent signal loss in sharp bends, which is particularly useful in dense urban or indoor installations .

Connector Types

Patch cords in Guyana typically use LC, SC, ST, or hybrid connectors:

- o LC connectors: Compact, duplex, and ideal for high-density environments like data centers.
- o SC connectors: Larger, push-pull design, commonly used in telecom networks.
- o ST connectors: Rugged, twist-on connectors suitable for industrial applications.
- o Hybrid cords: Combine different connectors (e.g., LC to SC) for versatile connectivity .

Jacket Materials and Safety

The outer jacket of patch cords can vary depending on installation requirements:

- o PVC: Standard indoor use.
- o LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen): Emits minimal smoke and toxic gases, suitable for high-safety areas.
- o OFNR/OFNP: Fire-resistant for vertical shafts or plenums .
