- o Tray Cable (TC, TC-ER): Designed for power and control wiring in ducts, conduits, and cable trays, tray cables are multiconductor and can be rated for direct burial. They are commonly used in large industrial panels .
- o Flexible Power Cable (DLO, Welding Cable): These cables are used where flexibility is required, such as in movable equipment or welding applications .

## Cable Functions in the Distribution Box

- o Live (Phase) Wires: Carry current from the main supply to the circuit breakers or fuses.
- o Neutral Wires: Complete the electrical circuit by returning current to the source.
- o Earth (Ground) Wires: Provide a safety path to prevent electric shock and protect equipment.
- o Connection to Busbars: Cables are often terminated on busbars inside the box, which distribute power to multiple circuits efficiently .

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Insulation type, temperature rating, and mechanical protection are critical to prevent hazards. Proper organization and labeling of cables also improve maintenance and reduce the risk of accidental contact with live parts.
