These fibers are used to transmit data as light signals, offering high-speed data transfer capabilities over long distances with minimal loss. The number of optical cores in an optical fiber is the total number of equipment interfaces multiplied by 2, plus 10% to 20% of the spare quantity, and if the communication mode of the equipment has serial communication and equipment multiplexing, you can reduce the number of cores.
