Before supplying power, the switch checks if the connected device supports PoE, preventing damage to non-PoE devices . The technology uses standard twisted-pair cables (Cat5e or higher) to carry both power and data efficiently.

Types of PoE Switches

- o PoE (IEEE 802.3af): Supplies up to 15.4W per port.
- o PoE+ (IEEE 802.3at): Provides up to 30W per port.
- o PoE++ (IEEE 802.3bt): Delivers up to 60W or 100W per port, suitable for high-power devices like advanced Wi-Fi 6 access points or PTZ cameras . Switches can also be managed or unmanaged. Managed PoE switches offer advanced features like traffic segmentation, monitoring, and centralized power management, while unmanaged switches provide basic plug-and-play functionality .
