- o Switches/Isolators: Enable manual control and safe disconnection of circuits.
- o Residual Current Devices (RCD/RCCB/RCBO): Detect leakage currents and prevent electric shocks.
- o Surge Protective Devices (SPD): Protect equipment from voltage spikes.
- o Earthing Connection: Ensures proper grounding for safety and system stability .
