A final distribution box is the last point in a low-voltage electrical system before electricity reaches end-user loads. It receives power from a main or sub-distribution board and divides it into multiple smaller circuits, ensuring each circuit is protected and isolated for safety and maintainability . It is sometimes referred to as a breaker box, fuse box, or consumer unit in residential settings .

Main Functions

- o Power Distribution: Breaks down incoming electricity into smaller circuits for lighting, sockets, HVAC, pumps, or other equipment .
- o Protection: Uses devices like MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers), RCBOs (Residual Current Breaker with Overcurrent), fuses, and RCDs (Residual Current Devices) to prevent overloads, short circuits, and earth leakage .
- o Isolation and Maintenance: Allows individual circuits to be safely turned off for maintenance or troubleshooting without affecting the entire system .

Components

- o Incoming Device: MCCB, MCB, or isolator controlling the board.
- o Outgoing Devices: MCBs, RCBOs, or fuses feeding each final circuit.
- o Busbars: For neutral and earth connections.
- o Enclosure: Metallic or insulated box, often wall-mounted, designed for safety and durability .

Types and Applications

- o Single-Phase FDBs: Common in residential or small commercial setups.
- o Three-Phase FDBs: Used in industrial or large commercial installations.
- o Surface-Mounted or Flush-Mounted: Depending on space, accessibility, and aesthetic requirements .
- o Customized FDBs: Designed for specific load capacities or specialized applications like solar or storage systems .
