The box also organizes excess fiber in trays, maintaining proper bend radius to prevent damage and simplify future maintenance .

Components and Structure

- o Splice cassette/tray: Holds the fibers and splices, often removable for easy installation and repair .
- o Front panel/connectors: Provides interfaces for fiber or copper connections, allowing integration with network devices .
- o Enclosure: Made from durable, corrosion-resistant materials, often rated IP68 for outdoor use, protecting fibers from water, dust, and temperature extremes .

Power and Hybrid Functionality

Some splice boxes, known as hybrid splice boxes, not only manage fiber connections but also deliver power to devices or network components, which is crucial for installations in hard-to-access indoor or outdoor locations . This allows the same enclosure to support both data transmission and power supply, reducing the need for separate infrastructure.
