A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber cable with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare, exposed fiber on the other. These cables are used mainly for digital audio connections between devices. The meaning of the end of the optical cable refers to: after the outdoor optical cable enters the machine room, the outer sheath of the optical cable is stripped to a certain length, so that the optical fiber sleeve and the reinforcing core are.
