

What size distribution box is needed for 18 circuits

- o Consider leaving 10-20% spare capacity for future circuit additions or modifications .
- o For outdoor installations, ensure proper sealing and cable gland selection to maintain the IP65 rating . This size is typical for residential, commercial, or light industrial applications requiring 18 outgoing circuits, providing a balance between compact footprint and sufficient wiring space.
