Additionally, maintain proper separation between fiber optic and power cables to support safe installation practices and long-term system reliability. For vertical cabling in risers, if possible, at least use the cable-rated OFNR. If possible, use an automated puller with tension control or at least a breakaway pulling eye. Know and observe the maximum recommended load. By pulling 2x dual-LC fibres, you can transform your 1 Gbit network speed to 400Gb/s by simply changing SPF adapters (OK, you'd need QSPF28 for 400GB/s, but you get the drift).
