Split cable guides and split 40-in sheave wheels are available to facilitate entry and exit from manholes. Lip rollers and quadrant blocks must not be used because the rollers themselves do not meet the minimum bend radius requirement. Underground cables are pulled in conduit that is buried underground, usually 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up.
