- o RCBOs (Residual Current Breakers with Overcurrent Protection): Combine overcurrent and earth fault protection for sensitive circuits.
- o Surge Protection Devices (SPD): Protect against voltage spikes from lightning or grid fluctuations .
- Ingress Protection (IP) Rating: For indoor residential use, an IP20 rating is generally sufficient, protecting against accidental contact with live parts and minor dust. Outdoor or damp areas may require higher IP ratings .
- Future-Proofing: Choose a box with extra capacity and modular design to allow easy addition of circuits or protective devices without replacing the entire unit .
