



Which one is the fiber optic light on the router

Optical Network Terminal (ONT) light: Indicates connection to fiber optic network. The "PON" light on a router stands for "Passive Optical Network. POWER Normal: Solid/stagnant light. If OFF: The router is not powered -- check the socket, adapter, or power cable. One of the key aspects of the ONT is the array of lights on its front. The LEDs on your modem, optical network terminal (ONT), router, or modem/router combo (gateway) are most likely blinking because they're communicating what the device is doing, or there's an error. Each networking device manufacturer may use slightly different patterns, but most follow similar conventions that have become industry standards. This light indicates whether your ONT is connected to a device--usually your eero(TM) router--via Ethernet.
