

Why is the fiber optic light on my router

- o Signal Issues: A blinking red LOS light signals a problem with the fiber signal, which could be caused by cable damage, loose connectors, or ISP service interruptions .

Troubleshooting Tips

- o Check Connections: Ensure the fiber optic cable is securely connected to the router's WAN or ONT port and that there are no visible bends or damage .
- o Power Cycle the Router: Turn off the router, unplug it for 30 seconds, then reconnect and power it on. Wait a few minutes for the light to stabilize .
- o Check for ISP Outages: Visit your ISP's website or social media for service updates if the light remains red or blinking .
- o Contact Support: If the light does not turn solid after troubleshooting, your router or fiber line may require professional inspection . In summary, a solid fiber optic light generally means your internet connection is active, while blinking or red lights indicate initialization or signal problems that may need attention.
