

Article Overview

Proper wiring of distribution boxes involves correct breaker selection, wire sizing, color coding, grounding, and safety inspections to ensure reliable and safe electrical distribution.

Material Preparation and Box Selection

Before wiring, gather all necessary materials: circuit breakers, wires, wiring ties, busbars, and protective devices. Choose a distribution box suitable for the environment (indoor or outdoor) with appropriate IP/NEMA ratings and durable materials such as steel or plastic for protection against dust, moisture, and mechanical damage. Ensure the box has sufficient space for future expansion and modular upgrades.

Wire Color Coding and Specifications

- o Phase wires: A phase - yellow, B phase - green, C phase - red
- o Neutral wire: Blue
- o Protective Earth (PE): Green/yellow striped
- o Wire sizing: Lighting and socket circuits typically use 2.5mm² wires; air conditioning or high-load circuits may require 4.0mm² wires.

Circuit Breaker Connections

- o 1P breakers: Control only the live wire; neutral bypasses the breaker and connects directly to the neutral busbar.
- o 2P breakers: Control both live and neutral wires, disconnecting both during a trip for full isolation.
- o Main switch: Preferably a 2P breaker with residual current protection (RCCB/RCD) to ensure total disconnection and protection against electric shock.

Wiring Method and Layout

- o Incoming power connects to the main isolator, then to the RCCB/RCD for leakage protection.
- o Phase lines from the RCCB are connected in parallel to MCBs for each subcircuit, while neutral lines connect to the neutral busbar.
- o Wiring direction: main circuit breaker to branch breakers on the left; outgoing circuits on the right.
- o Use parallel connections where necessary to simplify wiring and reduce congestion.

Safety and Organization

Wiring Method for Angolan Distribution Boxes

- o Secure wires with plastic ties, maintaining uniform spacing and straight runs .
- o Clearly label all circuits, voltage levels, and AC/DC designations .
- o Perform visual inspections and multimeter tests to check for short circuits, overloads, and proper grounding before powering on .
- o Schedule regular maintenance and inspections to ensure long-term reliability .

Protective Devices

- o Include breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit .
- o Ensure RCCB/RCD devices are installed to protect against earth faults and leakage currents . By following these wiring methods, distribution boxes in Angola can be installed safely, efficiently, and in compliance with general electrical standards, while allowing for future upgrades and maintenance.
