Proper wiring of a large distribution box involves careful planning, secure connections, correct circuit breaker installation, and thorough testing to ensure safety and compliance.

Preparation and Planning

Before starting, ensure the main power is completely turned off and verify with a tester. Select a suitable location that is dry, ventilated, and away from flammable or corrosive substances. - o Install Circuit Breakers: Place independent breakers according to load requirements. Include RCDs or RCBOs if needed for additional protection .
- o Connect Input and Output Wires:
 - o Connect the incoming live wire to the main terminal.
 - o Connect phase to phase, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground following color coding standards.
 - o Secure wires using screws or crimping tools to ensure tight, conductive connections .
- o Busbars and Terminal Blocks: Attach wires to busbars or terminal blocks neatly, leaving space for heat dissipation. Use cable ties to organize wiring and prevent tangling .
- o Label Circuits: Clearly mark each circuit for easy identification during maintenance or troubleshooting .

Testing and Verification

- o Insulation Resistance Test: Measure resistance between wiring and the box to ensure it meets safety
