Proper wiring of a booth's electrical distribution box involves connecting the main supply to the main breaker, distributing power to branch circuits, and ensuring correct grounding and protective devices are installed.

Main Components and Connections

A booth's distribution box, also called a distribution board, serves as the central hub for distributing electricity safely to all circuits within the booth . Key components include:

- o Main Circuit Breaker (MCB): Connects the incoming power supply (phase and neutral) to the distribution box. In single-phase setups, a double-pole MCB is typically used as the main switch .
- o Branch Circuit Breakers: Single-pole or double-pole MCBs distribute power to individual loads or equipment within the booth .
- o Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB): Provides protection against leakage currents, insulation failures, and electric shocks. The RCCB is connected downstream of the main MCB and upstream of branch MCBs .
- o Neutral and Earth Links: Neutral wires from all branch circuits connect to the neutral bar, while all grounding wires connect to the earth bar to ensure safety .

Wiring Procedure

- o Power Off: Ensure the main supply is turned off and verify with a voltage tester before starting .
- o Plan Layout: Determine the number of circuits, their load requirements, and the path of wiring inside the box .
- o Connect Main Supply: Attach the incoming phase and neutral wires to the main MCB. Connect the earth wire to the earth bar .
- o Branch Circuit Wiring: Connect each branch circuit to its respective MCB. Typically, wiring from the main breaker to branch breakers is routed on the left side, and wiring exiting the box goes to the right .
- o Grounding: All metallic parts of the booth must be bonded to the earth bar to prevent accidental shocks. Use a continuous grounding conductor from the service to the booth .
- o Wire Management: Use plastic ties to bind wires neatly, ensuring uniform spacing and avoiding kinks or overlaps .
- o Labeling: Clearly mark AC/DC circuits and voltage levels for easy identification and maintenance .
- o Inspection: After wiring, perform a safety inspection to check for short circuits, overloads, and proper grounding .

Safety Considerations

- o Always follow local electrical codes and standards.

- o Ensure all connections are tight and insulated to prevent arcing.
- o Verify grounding continuity before energizing the system . By following these steps, the booth's electrical distribution box will be safely wired, providing reliable power distribution and protection for all connected equipment.
