Proper wiring in a distribution box involves connecting the main power to the main MCB, distributing power through branch MCBs or RCCBs, and ensuring all phase, neutral, and earth wires are correctly linked and safely insulated.

Step-by-Step Wiring Process

1. **Safety First:** Always turn off the main power supply before starting any wiring work to prevent electrical shock .
2. **Mounting the Distribution Box:** Secure the box to a wall at an accessible height, ensuring the installation site is free of obstructions .
3. **Connecting the Main Power:**
 - o Identify the incoming live (phase) wire, typically brown or red, and connect it to the main MCB or main terminal .
 - o Connect the neutral wire from the supply to the neutral bus bar.
 - o Connect the earth wire to the earth link, which may come from the supply cable or an earth pit .
4. **Installing Circuit Breakers:**
 - o Place the main MCB (usually a double-pole 63A for domestic use) in the designated slot .
 - o Install single-pole MCBs for individual sub-circuits such as lighting or socket outlets. For special loads, double-pole MCBs may be used .
 - o If using an RCCB, connect the output of the main MCB to the RCCB input, then distribute power to the load MCBs .
5. **Connecting Sub-Circuits:**
 - o Connect the phase wire from the output of the RCCB to the input of each load MCB.
 - o Connect the neutral wire from the RCCB output to the neutral bus bar.
 - o Connect the earth wire from each load to the earth link .
6. **Wiring Direction and Organization:**
 - o Typically, wiring from the main circuit breaker to branch breakers is on the left, and outgoing circuits are on the right .

- o Use plastic ties to bind wires neatly, maintaining uniform spacing and avoiding kinks .
- o Clearly mark all wires for phase, neutral, and earth, as well as voltage levels .

7. Testing and Inspection:

- o After wiring, use a multimeter to check for secure connections, continuity, and absence of short circuits .
- o Ensure no circuits are overloaded and all exposed wires are properly insulated .

Additional Tips

- o Choose MCB and RCCB ratings according to the load requirements of your installation .
- o Pre-wire sub-circuits (lighting, sockets, AC units) before connecting them to the distribution box for easier installation .
- o Regularly inspect connections for looseness or wear to maintain safety and reliability .
